MEMBERSHIP QUESTIONS

Before you join.

Are clay and firing included in the studio membership?

Yes. Clay and standard firing costs are included in the \$400 monthly studio membership. Specialty materials, unusually large work, production-scale firing, or nonstandard processes may require prior approval or an additional fee.

Who is the studio membership designed for?

It is intended for responsible adult artists who can work independently, follow studio procedures, and contribute positively to a shared creative environment.

Is a sustaining membership tax-deductible?

VETART is fiscally sponsored by Social and Environmental Entrepreneurs. The tax-deductible portion depends on whether goods, services, or benefits are provided. VETART will provide appropriate documentation and can clarify the structure before enrollment.

Can a company become a sustaining member?

Yes. Businesses, foundations, professional firms, employee resource groups, and family philanthropies are encouraged to participate. Recognition and engagement opportunities can be tailored to the organization and support level.

Can I tour the studio first?
